<b>Accommodation</b>	Half-board Mon-Fri, full-board weekend. Prices are based on two or three students sharing a room.	£33 per night
<b>Lunch Allowance</b>	Optional Mon-Fri service. Students are provided cash each day to buy lunch.	£5 per person per day
<b>Activities</b>	Afternoon/evening activities such as Castle Museum, Evening Ghost Walk, York Dungeons and many more.	£12 per person

# Sample Programme and Costs

## Group Itinerary - 30 students plus 1 group leader

- Sunday: Arrival Day - airport transfer and host families included in the package. The group will be met by English in York staff and host families on arrival into York.
- Bus passes are included so that the group has unlimited travel across York.
- Monday - Friday: General English 09.30 - 12.30.
- Lunch: 12.30 - 13.30 daily - lunch allowance included at £5 per student per school day.
- 3 x afternoon activities are included - variety of options such as York Minster, Jorvik Viking Centre and York Castle Museum.
- 1 x excursion is included - different options to choose from such as Leeds, Manchester and Whitby.
